Global First: First Programme of Activities Issues CERs

In partnership with the Mexican Government, Cool nrg International would like to announce that it has become the first company to issue carbon emission reductions (CERs) from a Programme of Activities. On the 28th December 2012 Cool nrg proudly issued 18,856 CERs from the first stage of its CUIDEMOS project in Mexico. (In Spanish, CUIDEMOS means "we care" and is an acronym for Campaign for Intelligent Energy Use in Mexico).

The Programme of Activities is a form of project under the Kyoto Protocol Clean Development mechanism that enables multiple small projects to be joined into a single project. The Programme of Activities therefore typically attracts community-based projects with a higher level of sustainable development.

Cool nrg Chairman, Nic Frances, said, "We are very excited to have delivered the world's first CERs from a Programme of Activities. Cool nrg is committed to delivering projects that are innovative, reduce $\rm CO_2$ and help communities. Our CUIDEMOS project meets all those goals. The amount of $\rm CO_2$ reduction associated with this issuance is equivalent to planting more than 100,000 trees, and 98% of the light bulbs went to families in the three poorest demographic sectors."

CUIDEMOS is a project owned and driven by Australian company Cool nrg International, and conducted in conjunction with the Mexican Government, Philips Lighting, and ING, with Dutch utility Eneco Energy Trade being the CER purchaser.

"We congratulate Cool nrg and the programme partners on passing this important milestone in the development of the CUIDEMOS programme. ING is proud to have been the project loan provider for the first project. The successful CER issuance proves the operating model for Programmes of Activities and is a tribute to the vision, pioneering spirit and perseverance of the Cool nrg team. About CUIDEMOS programme of activities

CUIDEMOS is a project that has the ability to be extended across Mexico for more than 30 million energy efficient lights. The first stage of this project, known as Luz Verde ("Green Light"), resulted in 1 million energy efficient light bulbs being distributed across the State of Puebla, Mexico. The project was conducted by Cool nrg in conjunction with the Mexican Government, Philips Lighting, Eneco and ING. The distribution of light bulbs occurred in November 2009. The project was the first of a number of stages, or "CPAs" under a programme of activities, under the Kyoto Protocol. The light bulbs were distributed through the Coppel and Comex retail chains allowing ordinary families to exchange their light bulbs during their daily activities. In 2011 Philips and Cool nrg distributed on behalf of the Mexican Government 22.9 million energy efficient lights to the poorest households of Mexico, the current value of CER's is currently not at a value that will cover costs of monitoring and issuance of any CERs associated with this program.
